Service steps

Step 1 → Log in using your UAE Pass account
Step 2 Submit the application form
Step 3 → Receive an NOC from TDRA addressed to the service provider
Step 4 > Contact the service provider to request lines
Step 5 → Notify TDRA of the connectivity readiness
Step 6 > Meeting between the FedNet team and the applicant
Step 7 Completing the required technical survey
Step 8 → TDRA will review the application and survey
