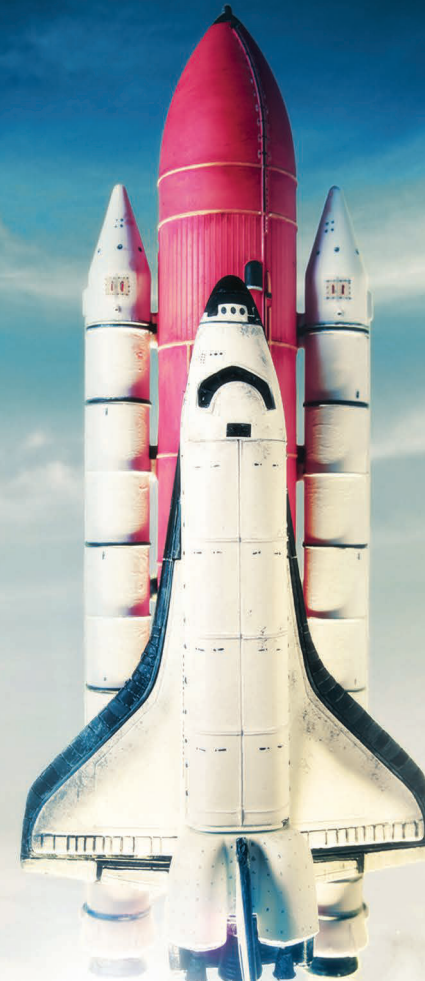

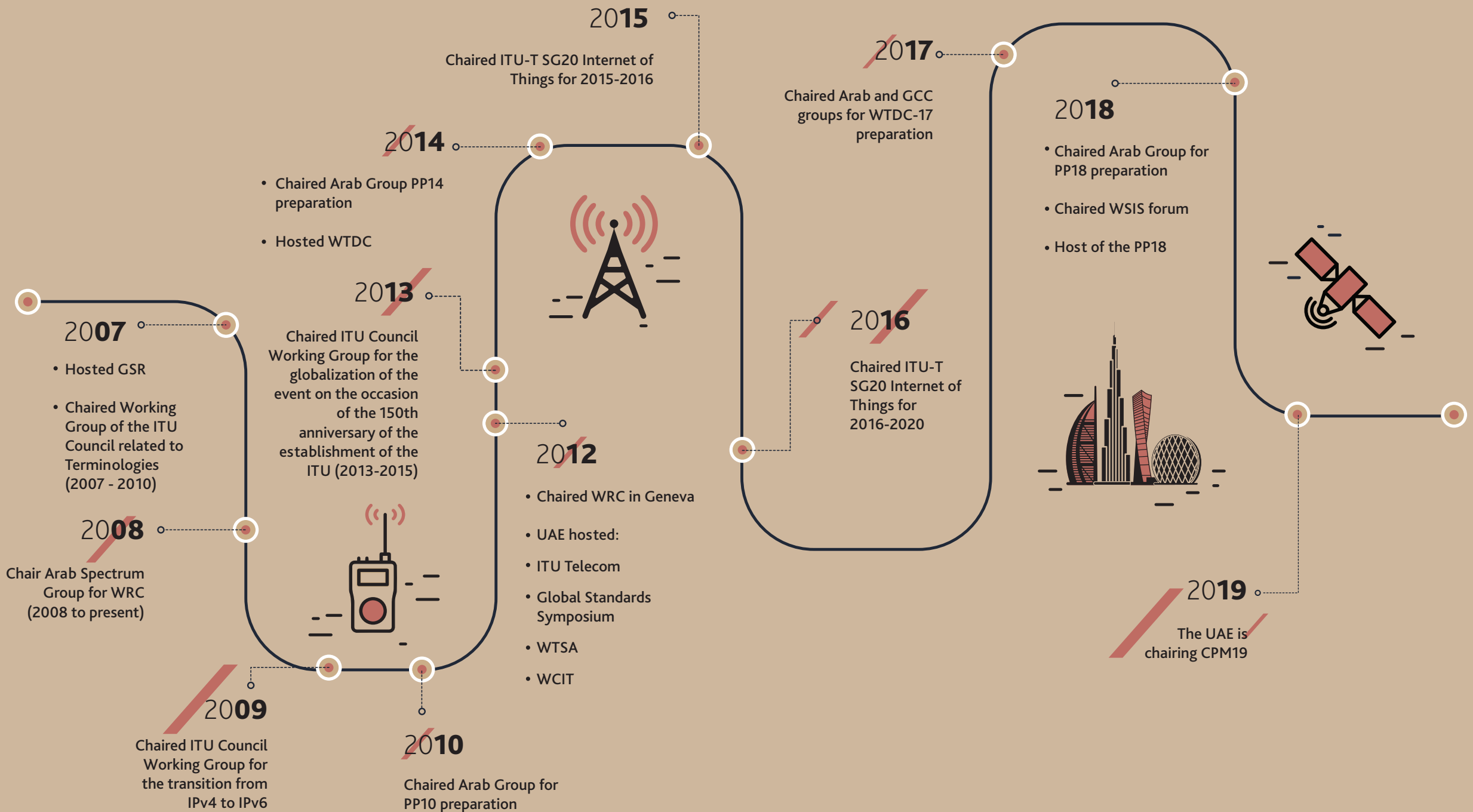
UAE VISION REACHES THE STARS

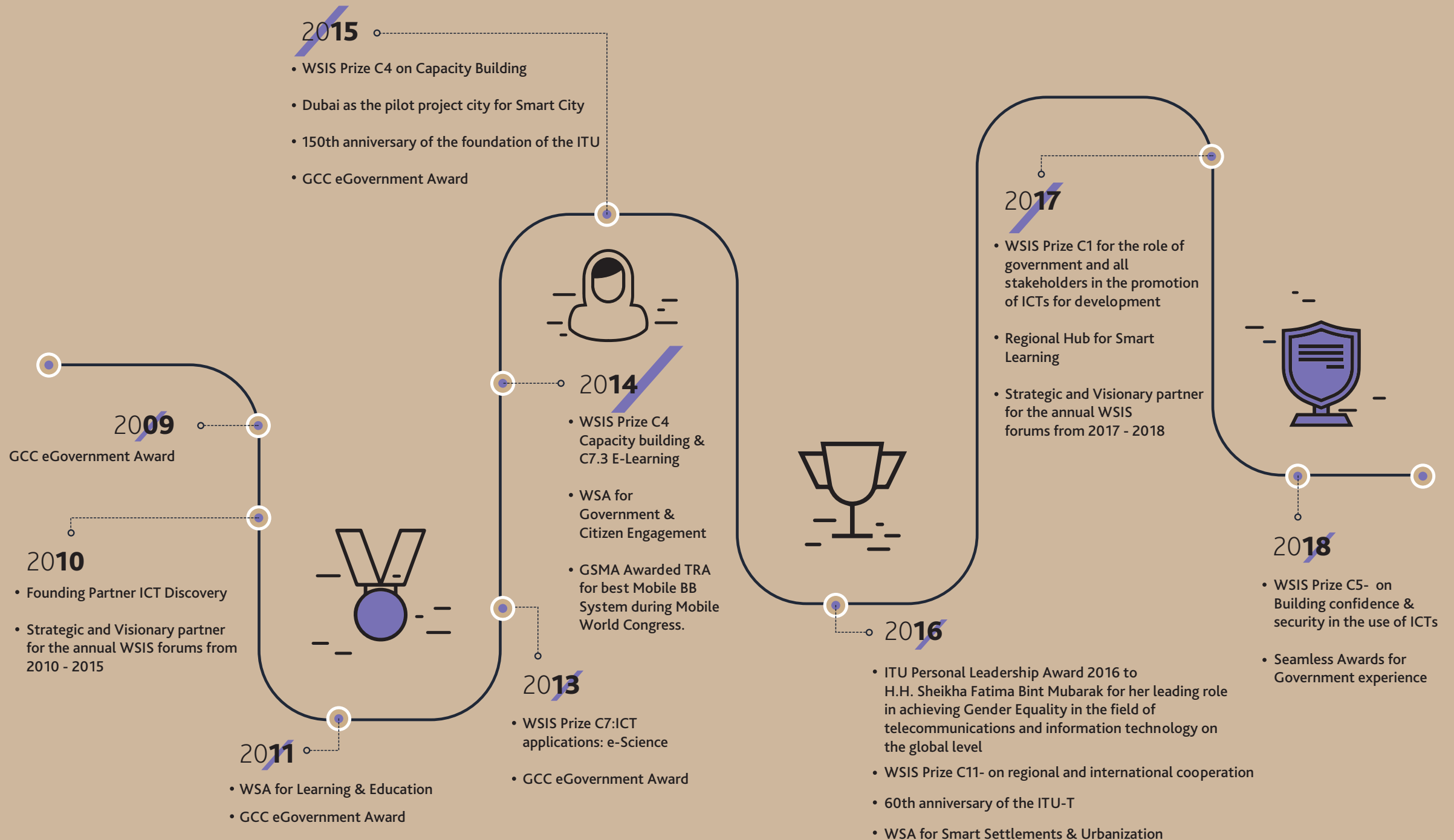
