About the Service/Feature

Through this service, TDRA renews wireless services authorizations to government, business and individuals

Service steps

- Step 1** → Login using the UAE Pass
- Step 2** → Fill in and submit the application form of renew the wireless device usage permit
- Step 3** → Pay the outstanding fees as per the issued invoice within the specified period, in accordance with the Spectrum Fees Regulation
- Step 4** → The Authority issues a renewed permit or license to use the wireless device and delivers it to the applicant electronically
