

## Modify SIM Card Point of Sale Registration

### About the Service/Feature

Through this service, the applicant can modify the details of SIM Card Point of Sale registration in the UAE.

### Service steps

- Step 1** → Log in using the UAE Pass
- Step 2** → Fill in the service application form
- Step 3** → Attach all required documents
- Step 4** → Pay service fees (if any)
- Step 5** → The application will be reviewed by a specialized team at the Authority
- Step 6** → Data modification on TDRA's system or obtaining an updated certificate, if the modification involves the trade name or geographical location
