About the Service/Feature

Through this service, TDRA issues wireless services authorizations to government, business and individuals

Service steps

- Step 1** → Register using UAE Pass
- Step 2** → Fill in and submit the authorization form for a permit or license to use a wireless device
- Step 3** → Pay the fees due according to the invoice issued within the specified period in accordance with regulatory regulations for frequency spectrum fees
- Step 4** → The Authority issues a permit or license to use the wireless device and delivers it to the applicant electronically
