

## Activate a government service on the federal network

### About the Service/Feature

FedNet provides connectivity between government entities for the purpose of exchanging and sharing data, which would save the entities the costs of direct connection with each entity independently.

### Service steps

- Step 1** → Log in using the UAE Pass
- Step 2** → Submit a service request
- Step 3** → Fill in the technical details questionnaire from the government entity and attach all required documents
- Step 4** → Review the application and the questionnaire by a specialized team at the Authority
- Step 5** → Receive the notification of service provision
