Service steps

- Step 1** → Register using UAE Pass
- Step 2** → Fill in the service application form
- Step 3** → Attach all required documents
- Step 4** → Pay service fees
- Step 5** → Review the application and approve it by a specialized team at the Authority
- Step 6** → Pay certificate fees
- Step 7** → Obtain a certificate of registration of telecommunications equipment

About	<p>Registering and approving telecommunications devices before they are displayed and sold in the country's market by submitting the information and documents required in the type approval system.</p> <p>Requirements vary depending on the degree of danger of the device to be approved. Device types have been identified for each degree of the danger and divided into three levels as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Level 1: Least dangerous and does not require a technical inspections. - Level 2: Medium risk and sometimes requires a technical inspection if requested by the Authority. - Level 3: is the most dangerous and requires a technical inspection of the devices. <p>Communication devices can be classified according to their risk levels in the "Service Remark" section.</p>
