Installing a security incident management system in the technical work environments and networks of the government entity, which provides alerts about potential risks, security incidents and vulnerabilities

### Service steps

- Step 1** → Log in using UAE Pass
- Step 2** → Submit a service request
- Step 3** → Receive the Rules of Engagement document from TDRA
- Step 4** → Fill in the form and attach the required data
- Step 5** → Review the application by a specialized team at the Authority
- Step 6** → Installing the SIEM
